Data protection is extremely important for any business, and the maritime industry is just at the beginning of its digital journey. There is an even bigger emphasis on this topic with the need to move away from the outdated and inefficient traditional manual, paper-based approaches, especially when it involves exchange of information from sea to shore and vice versa. The increasing requirements to comply with regulations and also to improve efficiency is driving the move to digitalized solutions, processes and reporting. As such, the topic of data protection is becoming more relevant and important. A clear example of digitalisation in the industry is that more owners realize the required efforts and are looking to automate their IHM Maintenance process. There are still great misunderstandings that data exchange and use automatically leads to unsafe and unsecured data, which we will clarify and uncover below.

### Data Security

Based on the traditional history of the shipping industry, there is understandably an uncertainty when moving to new solutions, due to the fear that data will be exploited and not securely held or transferred. Sharing of data and collaboration can cause risks to lose valuable data and company knowledge. However, when strict data policies and storage are correctly adhered to, guidelines followed, and data regulations applied as a standard within a business, you can be sure that data is used to improve your business and ease compliance burdens while maintaining full control of your data.
